## Truth Affirmation – Tender Digital Health Platform

The request to participate in the procurement must be signed by a person authorized to represent the company. Karolinska University Hospital may verify the authorization. In such cases, the Candidate must be able to demonstrate that the authorization was in place by the final request day to submit tender. A signed Truth Affirmation confirms that the authorized representative, in good faith and with integrity, certifies that:

- The Company has accessed and based its request to participate on the complete documents in the invitation, including any clarifications and supplements published in the specified manner in TendSign up until the final request day for submit tender.
- All information provided in the request to participate in tendering is truthful.

Furthermore, the person who signs the Truth Affirmation assures that no individual who is a member of the applicant company or any other companies whose capacity is invoked as administrative, managerial, or supervisory bodies, or who has the authority to represent, make decisions in, or control these entities:

- i. Is subject to any of the exclusion grounds stipulated in Chapters 13, Sections 1, 2, and 3 §§, or;
- ii. That any of the specified exclusion grounds are applicable, but that, in consideration of what is stipulated in Chapter 13, Section 5 § of the Public Procurement Act (LOU), there are grounds for exemption from exclusion.
